Dear Parent/Carer

We currently have vacancies for three parent governors. We are writing to all parents/carers of children registered to attend Brunel School to invite you to express an interest in becoming a governor.

What is involved?

As part of the Local Governing Body you have two main purposes:

- 1. To make sure the vision and priorities of the school are being met
- 2. To provide challenge and support for the School Leadership Team on; Monitoring effectiveness of provision and school improvement (including; pupil premium, sports premium grant), Safeguarding, Well-being, representing views of school-based community stakeholders

What is the time commitment?

- One 2 hour meeting every term
- One school monitoring visit per term
- One governor development day (held in the Autumn term)
- Initial governor training

There are circumstances which disqualify a person from becoming a governor; these are detailed on the application form attached. All governors on appointment will be subject to an enhanced Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) check.

I confirm that I:

- Am aged over 18
- Am not a current pupil at the school
- Am not the subject of a bankruptcy restrictions order, an interim bankruptcy restrictions order, a dept relief restrictions order, an interim dept relief restrictions order or an undischarged sequestration
- Have not been disqualified from holding office as a governor
- Have not been removed from office as an elected governor within the last 5 years
- Am not included in the list of those unsuitable to work with children or disqualified from working with children, barred from regulated activity and/or disqualified from registering for childminding or providing daycare
- Have not been sentenced to 3 months or more in prison (without the option of a fine) in the 5 years before becoming a governor or since becoming a governor
- Have not received a prison sentence of 2 and a half years or more in the 20 years before becoming a governor
- Have not at any time received a prison sentence of 5 years or more
- Have not been fined for causing a nuisance or disturbance on school premises during the 5 year prior to or since appointment or election as a governor
- Agree for my name and statement to be published to all parents within the voting pack, in the event of more than one nomination being received

If a parent governor, I also confirm that i:

- Am not an elected member of the local authority
- Am not paid to work at the school for more than 500 hours in a year
- Have a child or children currently attending the school
